

Windsor Township Stormwater Management

Pennsylvania Act 167 was authorized on October 4, 1978 (32 P.S., P.L. 864) and gave Pennsylvania Municipalities the power to regulate activities that affect stormwater runoff, surface and groundwater quantity and quality. The Windsor Township Stormwater Management Ordinance affects all NEW development in Windsor Township. Individual home construction projects on single family lots which result are exempt under Section 402 of Windsor Township Stormwater Ordinance, are not required to submit formal drainage plans to Windsor Township; however, they must still address Water Quality and Groundwater Recharge criteria specified in the Stormwater Management (Ord. Sections 305 and 306). A Stormwater Management Application with applicable fees must be submitted to Windsor Township for processing for any Regulated Activity to include but not limited to: single family home, garage, sheds, driveways and accessory structures.
